COURSE COVERAGE

Our comprehensive courses and course material are designed to thoroughly prepare your child for the 11+ common entrance exam for prestigious schools such as Reading School, Kendrick, and the Slough Consortium. Additionally, we ensure that our students are well-equipped to confidently tackle tests administered by various other examination boards, including GL, FSCE, SET, CEM Select, CSSE, ISEB, and Independent Schools.

COURSE OPTIONS

We understand that every child has unique learning needs, which is why we offer multiple course options to provide flexibility. Our Fully Comprehensive Course is available in both Classroom and Online formats, ensuring that your child receives a complete learning experience. For those who prefer self-study, we offer the DIY option, which includes access to all the materials and online resources used in our classroom courses. You will be liable for the fees up to the end of the notice period. In case of a mid-course withdrawal, any discounts will be invalidated, and you will be required to pay for the sessions attended (calculated based on the full course fee), including the notice period, along with a £30 administrative fee. If a student stops attending without prior notice, the notice period will be deemed to have begun from the lesson following the final attendance, and you will be liable for the fees for 4 sessions after the last attended session.

LATE PAYMENTS

We expect timely payments and do not accept late payments. A standing order is mandatory for all course fees. Late payments may incur a £10 fine for each occurrence. 
